Award from the Luís de Camões Chair of the Carlos III University of Madrid to the best work by young researchers (under 35 years of age) presented as an oral communication at the VIII IBERIAN CONGRESS OF ICTYOLOGY (SIBIC 2020).

BASES

The Organizing Committee of the VIII IBERIAN CONGRESS OF ICTYOLOGY (SIBIC 2020) announces an award for the best communication presented at the Congress by young researchers (under 35 years old). This award is sponsored by the Luís de Camões Chair of the Carlos III University of Madrid. The prize will be awarded in accordance with the following rules:

Participants

The requirements for the award are as follows:

- 1.1. To fulfil one of the following conditions to be a young researcher.
 - Be under 35 years old on 15 June 2020, verified by an identification document (CC, DNI or passport).
 - To be carrying out a postgraduate training activity in any of its modalities and to prove this condition with documents.
- 1.2. Be the first author of the communication.
- 1.3. Be registered at the congress with an oral communication.
- 1.4. The work must be unpublished, i.e. it cannot be published in a scientific journal before June 2020.

2. Registration

To be eligible for the award (in addition to meeting the requirements in section 1) you must send an e-mail to xestioneventos@usc.es attaching documents that prove you meet the requirements of section 1.1, mentioning in the subject "Premio VIII Congreso Ibérico de Ictiología (SIBIC 2020) – Jóvenes Investigadores" and indicating in the body of the message the following information:

- Full name and number of your identification document (CC, DNI or passport)
- Title of the communication.

3. Jury and evaluation of applications

The jury will be composed of five chosen members of the Scientific and Organizing Committee of the VIII Iberian Congress of Ichthyology (SIBIC 2020). Co-authors of the works presented, thesis advisors of the candidates or people who have a contractual relationship with the candidates cannot be part of it. The jury will evaluate the presentations considering the work sent to the congress in any of its thematic areas.

The jury is sovereign in its decisions, and there is no right of appeal.

The jury may declare the award void.

4. Prize

The young researcher, author of the winning communication will receive a cash prize of 500 euros. In addition, the co-authors of the communication will receive a certificate attesting the awarding. The notification of the awarding of the prize and its presentation will be made at the closing session of the congress.

5. Reservation of rights

The Organizing Committee of the VIII Iberian Congress of Ichthyology (SIBIC 2020) reserves the right to modify the conditions of the award whenever there is a justified cause.

6. Acceptance of the contest rules

Participation in the prize implies full acceptance of its rules.

7. Confidentiality and intellectual property rights

The personal information and documentation provided by the candidates will be treated by the Organization and by the jury in a confidentially and the access to it will be restricted. The awarded authors will maintain the intellectual property of the work.
